OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Armigus on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that neither freight nor passenger business was transacted at the station herein proposed to be abandoned during the year ending February 28, 1926; that no passenger fares are published in the tariffs of applicant which are applicable to said station; that the abandonment of the said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there exists no reason for the continued maintenance of the non-agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Armigus on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records.
