OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of the non-agency station of Tubig, located on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger nor freight business was transacted at this station during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that there are no passenger fares published in its tariffs and applicable to said station; that the proposed abandonment will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there is no public necessity for the continued maintenance of the non-agency station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Tubig, said station being located on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
