BY THE COMMISSION:

FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER.

WHEREAS, in Decision No. 11,096 (22 C.R.C. 394) in the above-entitled matter, this Commission provided that such rates therein established would upon order of the Railroad Commission be subject to decrease on the basis of three (3) cents per thousand cubic feet of gas for each ten (10) cents decrease in the cost of oil below the price of \$1.50 per barrel F.O.B. Hanford; and

WHEREAS, Hanford Gas and Power Company now makes affidavit that on and after July 1, 1926, the price of oil was reduced to \$1.15 per barrel, making the present price of oil thirty-five cents per barrel below the base price established in Decision No. 11,096,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Hanford Gas and Power Company reduce its present rates effective for all meter readings taken on and after August 1, 1926, so that said rates shall be equal to ten (10) cents per thousand cubic feet less than the basic rates established in Decision No. 11,096.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Hanford Gas and Power Company

file with this Commission on or before July 26, 1926, a revision of its rates as herein ordered.
