## OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of the non-agency station of Kinsele, located on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that neither passenger nor freight service has been transacted at the non-agency station, herein proposed to be abandoned, during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that there are no passenger rates published in tariffs applicable to said non-agency station; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, the maintenance of the non-agency station is no longer necessary.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY CEDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Kinsale on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County, and to eliminate said non-agency

station name from its station records.
