Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Summit Hotel on its Sacramento Division in Placer County.

Applicant alleges that the non-agency station, herein proposed to be abandoned, was originally established to care for business existing at "Summit Hotel"; that said hotel was destoyed by fire some two years last past; that the destruction of the hotel and the construction of a second main track by applicant between Emigrant Gap and Andover have so changed conditions in the vicinity of Summit Hotel Station that the further maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public; that no freight business was transacted at this station during the yearly period ending March 31, 1926; and that no passenger business was transacted at said station during the yearly period ending with the month of April, 1926, there being no fares published in passenger tariffs and applicable to such station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Summit Hotel on its Sacramento Division in Placer County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
