OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Omena, on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that neither freight nor passenger business have been transacted at the non-agency station, herein proposed to be abandoned, during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that no passenger rates or fares are published in applicant's tariffs applicable to said non-agency station; that the abandonment of the non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, the continued maintenance of said non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HERRBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Omena as located on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
