OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of the non-agency station of Ainrof, located on the Oil City Branch of applicant's San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that there was neither passenger nor freight business transacted at said non-agency station during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926, there being no tariff fares published for passenger business and applicable to said station; that the abandonment of the non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, there is no necessity for the continued maintenance of said station.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Ainrof on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
