OPINION and CRDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Willcut on the Lake Tahoe Branch of its Sacramento Division in Placer County.

Applicant alleges that neither freight nor passenger business were transacted at this station during the yearly period ending June 30, 1926; that the abandonment of the non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not required for the business of the applicant nor for the public.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant. Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon the non-agency of Willcut on the Lake Tahoe Branch of applicant's Sacramento Division in Placer County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
