SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, Jesus Romero, who operates an automobile service for the transportation of passengers, freight, express and baggage between Darwin and Olancha, under authority of the Railroad Commission, as shown by Decision No. 9215, dated July 11, 1921, and issued on Application No. 6987, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of July 16, 1926, that he desires to discontinue the service, having lost a large part of his revenue through failure to secure a renewal of contract with the U.S. Government to transport U.S. mail.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Jesus Romero be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue the automobile service hereinabove described on July 1, 1926, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Jesus Romero in Decision No. 9215 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
