SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

The Railroad Commission by Decision No. 15186, dated July 16, 1925, as modified by Decision No. 15828, dated December 31, 1925, having granted to Aaron Buchheim a certificate of public convenience and necessity covering the construction and operation of a water system in Blocks 41 to 54, inclusive, of the Townsite of San Juan-by-the-Sea, to become effective only upon the securing by Aaron Buchheim of the proper consent, franchise or permit from the County of Orange; the filing with the Commission of a certified copy of such consent, permit or franchise; and the issuance of a supplemental order by this Commission; and a certified copy of a franchise (Ordinance No. 246) passed by the Board of Supervisors of Orange County on July 16, 1925, having been filed with this Commission,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted to Aaron Buchheim by said Decision No. 15186, dated July 16, 1925, as amended by Decision

No. 15828, dated December 31, 1925, shall become effective on the date of this order and continue in effect until modified by a further order of this Commission.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by this Commission in said Decision No. 15186, as amended by said Decision No. 15828, and made effective by this supplemental order shall apply only to Blocks 41 to 54, inclusive, of the Townsite of San Juan-by-the-Sea, County of Orange.
