ORDER OF DISMISSAL

J. T. Crothers has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an auto trucking service between Turlock, Modesto and Ceres and vicinity and Oakland and San Francisco.

A public hearing on this application was conducted by Examiner Austin and the matter submitted. Under date of August 10, 1926, the Railroad Commission was advised by the applicant, in writing, that he did not propose to operate between fixed points or over a regular route or routes.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
