ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Ernest F. Zanetta has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an auto trucking service between Monterey and San Francisco.

A public hearing on this application was conducted by Examiner Satterwhite and the matter submitted. Under dates of July 16th and August 6, 1926, the Railroad Commission requested the applicant, in writing, to advise the Commission whether he proposed to operate as a common carrier or as a carrier under private contract.

On August 7, 1926, Hudson, Martin and Jorgensen, Attorneys for applicant, advised that the service he proposed to operate was that of a private contract carrier. The Railroad Commission has no jurisdiction over any but common carriers.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this application be and the same hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
