IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that A. J. Arnaudon be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to Mendota Mutual Water Company, an unincorporated association, a certain public utility water system supplying consumers in the town of Mendota, Fresno County, more particularly described in the above numbered application, subject to the following conditions:

> 1. The consideration for the transfer herein authorized shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value for rate fixing or for any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.

The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been completed on or before November 30th, 1926, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this Commission by A. J. Arnaudon within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.
- 3. Within ten (10) days from the date on which A. J. Arneudon actually relinquishes control and possession of the property herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement indicating the date upon which such control and possession was relinquished.
