SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, S. A. Porter, who operates an automobile service for the transportation of passengers, baggage, freight and express between Maxwell and Stonyford, under authority of the Railroad Commission, as shown by Decision No. 12192, dated June 9, 1923, and issued on Application No. 9100 has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of August 26, 1926, that he desires to discontinue the service, having lost a large part of his revenue through failure to secure a renewal of his contract with the U. S. Government to transport U.S. mail.

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that S.A. Porter be and he hereby is authorized to discontinue the automobile service hereinabove described, and

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to S.A. Porter in Decision No. 12192 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
