BY THE COMMISSION -

OPINION and ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the moving and re - location of its passenger shelter shed at Mococo on its Western Division in Contra Costa County.

Applicant alleges that the passenger shelter station at Mococo is now located on the southerly side of the main track and obstructs the view of a switch located near said shelter station and interferes with switching operations at said station; and that to remedy such condition applicant proposes to move said passenger shelter station to a location on the northerly side of the main line track where said shelter station will not obstruct the view of switches and interfere with switching operations at Mococo Station.

Attached to the application, and as a part thereof, is a blue print map showing in yellow color the present location of the shelter station and in red color the proposed new location. The changed location places the shelter station on the northerly side of applicant's main line track, instead of the southerly side as heretofore located, and the new location offers the same facility of highway access as has heretofore existed at the present site.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to move and relocate its passenger shelter station at Mococo on its Western Division in Contra Costa County, said relocation establishing the shelter station on the northerly side of applicant's main line at a point opposite the present location on the southerly side of applicant's said main line.
