ORDER OF DISMISSAL

George A. Bigard has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by him of an auto trucking service in the vicinity of Bakersfield and Morced.

Public hearings on this application were conducted by Examiner Austin at Bakersfield and the matter submitted. Under date of September 10, 1926, the Railroad Commission was advised by G. H. Baker, Attorney, for applicant, in writing, that inasmuch as the service proposed was not an operation within the meaning of the Auto Stage and Truck Transportation Act (in the light of the Ben Moore decision) in that it was not an

operation between fixed points or over a regular route or routes, he desired that the application be dismissed without prejudice.
