O P I N I O N

Pacific Gas and Electric Company has applied to the Commission for approval of a certain agreement between applicant and Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company, a copy of said agreement being attached to the application and marked "Exhibit A".

Under this agreement, it is proposed that applicant shall deliver gas to Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company for resale from the latter's gas distribution system in Contra Costa County. The gas thus delivered will supplement the supply from Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company's gas generating plant located at Pittsburg, California.

In view of the nature of the service contemplated, applicant's filed schedules do not apply.

A public hearing is not deemed necessary.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to the Commission for approval of a certain agreement entered into between

it and Coast Counties Gas and Electric Company and the Commission being fully informed thereon,
