OPINION and ORDER

ORIGINAL

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the discontinuance and abandonment of its non-agency station of Tahoe City now located on the Lake Tahoe Branch of its Sacramento Division in Placer County.

Applicant alleges, as justification for the granting of the application, that the non-agency station of Tahoe City is located two-tenths of a mile from the agency station of Tahoe Tavern; that no passenger business has been handled at said non-agency station during the month of May, 1926; that the freight business now handled at said non-agency station can conveniently be handled by the agency station at Tahoe Tavern; that the abandonment of the said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, the continued maintenance of said non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant nor for the public.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to discontinue and abandon the maintenance of its non-agency station of Tahoe City

on the Lake Tahoe Branch of its Sacramento Division in Placer
County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its
station records.
