OPINION and ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of a freight shed located at the non-agency station of Ramona Park on the Covina Line of its Northern Division in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that the freight shed was established to care for less-than-carload shipments; that during the past twelve months but one shipment has been handled; yielding a revenue of fifty cents; and that because of the limited use made of this facility by the public there is no apparent necessity for the continued maintenance of the freight shed.

The location of the freight shed, herein proposed to be abandoned, is shown in yellow color on a blueprint map, marked "C.E.R.9936", as attached to and forming a part of the application herein.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and the same is authorized to abandon and remove its freight shed as heretofore maintained at the non-agency station of Ramona Park on the Covina Line of applicant's

northern Division in Los Angeles County.
