OPINION and ORDER

**ORIGINAL**

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Boaz on the Oil City Branch of its San Joaquin Division in Kern County.

Applicant alleges that neither freight nor passenger business was transacted at said non-agency station during the yearly period ending February 28, 1926; that there are no passenger fares published in tariffs and applicable to said station; that the abandonment of the non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of the applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency is unnecessary as any business offering can be conveniently handled by the agency station of Seguro.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon the maintenance of its non-agency station of Boaz on the Oil City Branch of the San Joaquin Division in Kern County, and to eliminate said non-agency station name from its station records.
