O R D E R

It appearing that the building in which the agency of applicant was operated in Amboy has been destroyed by fire, that applicant's agent will not continue to act as such, that there is now no one available to operate applicant's agency and that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not required;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Postal Telegraph-Cable Company be granted authority to discontinue its telegraph office in Amboy on and after December 1, 1926, providing Postal Telegraph Company notifies this Commission of its discontinuance within ten (10) days thereafter.

For all other purposes, the effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from and after the date hereof.
