The new public team tracks proposed to be constructed by the railroad company in its yard re-arrangement will be conveniently located with respect to the warehouse served by this spur proposed to be abandoned.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company to abandon and remove its spur track serving the warehouse owned by C. E. Lee and leased by L. E. Roof and located at Fourth and Wilson Streets in Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, and as more definitely shown in red on map attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
