ORDER

Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company. a corporation. has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of an industrial spur track serving the warehouse owned by C. E. Lee and leased to L. E. Roof and located at the corner of Fourth and Wilson Streets in Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, and shown in red on a blue-print map attached to and forming a portion of the application.

Applicant alleges that the track herein proposed to be abandoned was paid for by applicant and is constructed in part on private property and a public street adjoining its station grounds.

Applicant further alleges that formerly there was a heavy car load movement to this industry but during the past several years such movements have fallen to less than two car loads a month. Applicant desires to build a new freight and passenger depot on its station grounds and to re-arrange its yard tracks and has filed application No. 13298 for authority to make the necessary changes in grade crossings. The site chosen for the new freight house requires the removal of the spur track covered by this proceeding. Mr. C. E. Lee and Mr. L. E. Roof, owner and tenant, respectively, of the ware-222

house served by this spur track, have advised the Commission that they are agreeable to its removal. The new public team tracks proposed to be constructed by the railroad company in its yard re-arrangement will be conveniently located with respect to the warehouse served by this spur proposed to be abandoned.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Petaluma and Santa Rosa Railroad Company to abandon and remove its spur track serving the warehouse owned by C. E. Lee and leased by L. E. Roof and located at Fourth and Wilson Streets in Santa Rosa, Sonoma County, and as more definitely shown in red on map attached to the application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
