

Decision No. 17704.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of Application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing it to abandon and remove a station building at San Ramon, Contra Costa County, California.

**ORIGINAL**

O P I N I O N

Southern Pacific Company filed the above entitled application on the 5th day of November, 1926, asking for authority to abandon and remove its station building at its non-agency station of San Ramon, on its San Ramon Branch, Western Division, in Contra Costa County, California.

Applicant alleges that said station building is of an old type with four living rooms upstairs, that said station building has been closed for some time, that it is not expected to be used again, that property owners in the vicinity do not object to its removal and that a suitable freight platform will be constructed in lieu of said station building.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its station building at its non-agency station of San Ramon on its San Ramon Branch, Western Division, in Contra Costa County, all of which

is shown on the map attached to the application, subject to the following conditions:

(1) That a suitable freight platform be constructed at said San Ramon Station.

(2) Nothing in this order is to be construed that any other facilities are to be removed or abandoned from said San Ramon Station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
