O P I N I O N

The Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order authorizing the abandonment and removal of the freight shed at Burnett Station on its Newport Beach Line, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

Applicant alleges that it maintains, and has for several years, a freight shed at Burnett Station on its Newport Beach Line, that said freight shed was arranged for the handling of less than carload freight shipments, but that during the past twelve months no shipments have been handled at this station. Because of the very limited use made of this facility, there is apparently no longer any necessity for maintaining said freight shed at this station.

This freight shed is located on the side of an embankment, inaccessible except by foot. Exhibits attached to application herein and investigation made by the Commission shows that no freight shipments have been handled to or from Burnett Station

within the last year, that the freight shed is no longer required at that locality, that it is deteriorating, that the applicant should be allowed to salvage same.

We are of the opinion that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that applicant, Pacific Electric Railway Company, a corporation, be and the same hereby is authorized to abandon and remove freight shed located at Burnett Station, on its Newport Beach Line, County of Los Angeles, State of California, more definitely shown in yellow color on blue print map marked "C E H 10109, Southern Division, Pacific Electric Company" as attached to and made a part of this application.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
