It appears to this Commission that the present proceeding is not one in which a public hearing is necessary; that it is nether reasonable no x practicable at this time to provide a grade separation or to aroid a grade crossing at the point mentioned in this application with said nodding avenue and that this appalcation should be granted subject to the conditions hereinafter specfixed, therefore

IT IS HEREPY CDNEPED that permission and authority bs and it is hereon granted to Southern Pacific Company to construct a
spur track at grade across Redaing avonuo in the vicinity of Brighton, Connty of Sacramento, State of California, at the jocation horeinefter particriariy described and as shom by the map (Secramento DIvision Drawing S-fi2Z-A) attached to the application.

DESCETEMIOI OF CROSSING
Beginning at a point on the northerly line of Redaing Atenue, said point elso being in the southeriy right of way Ifne of the Southern Pacisic Company's comnecting tractic between the placervilie Branch and the main inno to Stockton and being 50 ieet sontheriy measurea at right angies from the center Ifre of said connecting track at Bngineor Station 1+85; thence westeriy across said Redaing Avenue on an arc of $a$ earre concere to the leit, with a radius of 440.97 feet, on are diftance of 72 foet more or less to a point on the westerly inne of Rediding ivenue.

The above crosging shail be identified as Croseing $2 T 0$. LE 94.54 S.

Said crossing to be constructol suogect to the followng conaf tions, nemoly:
(1) Mhe entire expense of constructing the crossing together with the cost of its maintenance thereafter in good and firstcless condition for the safo end convenient use of the prolic, siali be borme by applicant.
(2) Said crossing shail be constructod substantialis in eccorcance with Standerd MO. 2, in General Oraer No. 72 of this Commission and shail be constracted at elevations as indicated on the groifile of map (Sacramento Division Drawing S-xiziA) attochod to the cpplication, and with gredes of approach not oxceedine forn (4) por cont; shall bo protected by a suitable crossing sign gna sheil in every way be rade safe for the passage thereover of vehicies and other road trafesc.
(3) Appiscant sheil, within thirty (30) days theroaftor, notify this Commssion, in wifting, of the compietion of tho ineteiIation of said crossing.
(4) If said crossing shail not have boen instejIed withen
one gear from the date of this order; the arthorizetion herein granted sharI then lapse and become void, unless further time is granted by srosecrent order.
(5) The Compassion reserves the right to make such further orders relative to the location, construction, operation, maintenonce and protection of said crossing as to it may seem right and proper, and to revoke 1 ts permission if, in its judgment, tho prozac convenience and necessity demand such action.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the ate hereof.
