SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 6187, dated March 12, 1919, and issued on Application No. 3727, granted to J. H. Jacobs a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of freight between Sacramento and Winters, and

WHEREAS, the records of the Department of Finance and Accounts of this Commission show that since 1922 no annual reports have been filed by said J. H. Jacobs and

WHEREAS, residents of the territory covered by the certificate granted to Jacobs have advised the Commission that he is no longer operating, and

WHEREAS, a registered letter addressed by this Commission to said Jacobs at Winters has been returned to the Commission marked "moved, left no address,"

Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to J.H. Jacobs in Decision No. 6187, be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
