ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Savage Draying Co., a corporation, applicant in the above entitled proceeding, has petitioned the Railroad Commission for an order declaring that public convenience and necessity require the operation by it of an automobile service for the transportation of milk and cream from the territory in the vicinity of Los Banos, Gustine, and Newman and the cities of San Jose, Palo Alto, Burlingame, San Mateo, San Francisco and Oakland via Pacheco Pass and peninsula highways.

The matter was set for hearing before Examiner Austin on February 26, 1926, and dropped from the calendar to be reset on request of applicant. Under date of December 27, 1926, applicant requested that the matter be dismissed.
