O P I N I O N

This is an application of Pacific Gas and Electric Company for an order approving a certain contract, dated December 5, 1926, entered into with the Dumbarton Bridge Company. A copy of this contract, marked Exhibit "A", is attached to the petition in this matter. The consumer will use electricity for lighting and power purposes in connection with the operation of the Dumbarton Bridge, situate in San Mateo County.

The contract provides for delivery of electric energy at 2,300 volts. The consumer must provide all necessary equipment beyond the metering point. Special rates are provided in the contract, which is for a period of three (3) years, and thereafter until termination by thirty (30) days' written notice by either party.

The contract is at all times subject to such changes and modifications as the Railroad Commission of the State of California may direct.

In view of the nature of this service, to which filed schedules do not apply, the terms of the contract appear to be reasonable.

O R D E R

Pacific Gas and Electric Company having applied to the Commission for an order approving a certain agreement entered into between applicant and Dumbarton Bridge Company, dated December 5, 1926, the Commission having considered the matter and being of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Gas and Electric Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to execute an agreement substantially in the same form as the agreement filed in this proceeding and marked Exhibit "A".

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted shall be effective from and after the date hereof.
