BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of application of Southern Pacific Company for an order authorizing the construction at grade of a proposed spur track across Spence Street, in the City of Monterey, County of Monterey, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, applicant herein, having on January 3rd, 1927, made a written request of the Commission asking that the location of the crossing as described in the Commission's Decision 17419 be moved in a westerly direction and approximately eight feet therefrom, and it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that applicant's request should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the description of the crossing given in Decision No. 17419, as follows: -

Beginning at a point on the south line of Spence Street, said point being distant easterly 22+ feet from the center line of Southern Pacific Railroad main tracks and 70+ feet from the easterly line of Foam Street; thence running northwesterly across Spence Street to a point on the north line of Spence Street, said point being distant easterly 28+ feet from the center line of Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and 75+ feet from the easterly line of Foam Street;

be and it is hereby amended as follows: -

BEGINNING at a point on the south line of Spence Street, said point being distant easterly 11.73 feet from the center line of Southern Pacific Railroad main tracks and 48.56 feet from the easterly line of Foam Street; thence running northwesterly across Spence Street to a point on the north line of Spence Street, said point being distant easterly 14.34 feet from the center line of Southern Pacific Railroad tracks and 51.17 feet from the easterly line of Foam Street.
