

Decision No. 17919.

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the abandonment of Linea Station, County of Los Angeles, State of California, and abandonment and removal of an industrial spur track at said Linea Station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Linea and removal of an industrial spur track constructed to serve the Santa Ana Sugar Company located at said non-agency Station on its Santa Ana Branch on its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County.

Applicant alleges that the track herein proposed to be abandoned is owned by applicant and is constructed in part on private property adjoining its right-of-way; that the track was constructed in 1916 on the industrial basis; that said spur track is not now used by said Santa Ana Sugar Company; that said Santa Ana Sugar Company has agreed to the proposed removal of said track; that said track is not now required nor likely to be required in the future.

Applicant further alleges that said non-agency Station of Linea is no longer necessary; that no passenger business was transacted at said Station for the annual period ending August 31, 1926; that no carload or less than carload business was handled

during said annual period, and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of said non-agency Station and said spur track is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station at Linea located on the Santa Ana Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Los Angeles County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company to abandon and remove its spur track constructed to serve the Santa Ana Sugar Company and located at said Station of Linea on its Santa Ana Branch line, Los Angeles County, California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
