IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that San Francisco-Richmond Ferry Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to withdraw from the Wells Fargo Bank and Union Trust Company, the sum of \$117.64 obtained from the sale of the stock authorized by Decision No. 8144, dated September 24, 1920, as amended, and to use such sum for the following purposes:-

Payment of state license tax that was due January 1, 1927..	\$100.00
Payment of cost of making certified monthly reports to this Commission for the year 1926	14.04
Payment of expenses incurred in complying with the terms of this Commission's Decision No. 17113, in excess of the \$100. authorized to be used by that decision	<u>3.60</u>
Total.....	<u><u>\$117.64</u></u>

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Wells Fargo Bank and Union Trust Company be, and it hereby is, authorized to permit the

withdrawal by San Francisco-Richmond Ferry Company of said sum of \$117.64 for said purposes.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the orders heretofore made in this application shall remain in full force and effect, except as modified by this supplemental order.
