BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA.

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon non-agency station at Blanchards, County of Ventura, State of California.

## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Blanchards on its Los Angeles Division in Ventura County.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-sgency station of Blanchards during the annual period ending July, 1926; that no less than carload business was transacted at said station during said annual period; that carload freight business in amount of \$843. was transacted at said station during the same period; that said Blanchards Station is within the yard limits of the Station of Santa Paula; that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application

should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Elanchards located on the Santa Paula Branch of its Los Angeles Division in Ventura County and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said non-agency station applicant will not abandon any of the facilities at said Elanchards Station, and that the patrons and industries adjacent to said facilities will continue to be served.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
