SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, B. & H. Transportation Co., Inc., has advised the
 Railroad Commission, in writing, under date of December 29, 1926,
 that the territory covered by the certificate of public conven-
 ience and necessity heretofore granted to said company by the
 Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 8159, dated September 25,
 1920, and issued on Application No. 5893 has been annexed by the
 City of Long Beach, and

WHEREAS, as a result of said annexation the bus line operations
 of said B. & H. Transportation Co., Inc., performed under said
 certificate, are now operations entirely within the limits of
 the municipality of Long Beach and therefore not subject to the
 jurisdiction of this Commission, and

WHEREAS, said B. & H. Transportation Co., Inc., has withdrawn
 tariffs covering the service authorized herein filed in its name
 with the Railroad Commission, and requested in writing that the
 certificate granted herein be revoked and annulled.
 Now, therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience
 and necessity heretofore granted to said B. & H. Transportation Co.,
 Inc., in Decision No. 8159 be and the same hereby is revoked and
 annulled.
