O R D E R

WHEREAS, Monrovia Telephone and Telegraph Company having filed an application with this Commission requesting authority to file and make effective a charge of five (5) cents for each local message made from established public pay stations; and

WHEREAS, the rendering of public pay station service will be in the interest of subscribers of the service of Monrovia Telephone and Telegraph Company and to the public, and it appearing that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Monrovia Telephone and Telegraph Company be and it is hereby authorized to charge and collect a sum of five (5) cents for each local telephone message made from public pay stations on and after March 1, 1927, providing such rate be

submitted for filing with this Commission on or before February 28, 1927.
