



It is proposed to transfer all the business of handling live stock from Hackstaff to Doyle, which is located a distance of 8.6 miles west, where an abundant water supply has been developed, whereas at Hackstaff the water supply is limited.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be and it is hereby granted to The Western Pacific Railroad Company to abandon its agency station at Hackstaff, and to abandon and remove its depot, stock yards, and spur tracks serving same, all of which are located on its Western Division, in Lassen County, State of California.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
