BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Chalon on its Coast Division in Monterey County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Chalon during the annual period ending October 31st, 1926; that three tons of less than carload business was transacted at said station during said annual period; that carload freight business in amount of Seven Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighteen Dollars (\$7,918.00) was transacted at said station during the same period; that the abandonment of said nonagency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the publication

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and authority be

and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Chalon located on the main line of its Coast Division in Monterey County, State of California, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records; provided, however, that coincident with the abandonment of said non-agency station applicant will include within the switching limits of Soledad Station the tracks and facilities now located at Chalon Station.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
