WHEREAS, Roscoe Venard, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 6018, dated December 24, 1918, and issued on Application No. 4264, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service as a common carrier for the transportation of passengers and express between Cutler and Badger, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of March 4, 1927, that on June 30, 1926, he discontinued operation of said automobile service, having on that date lost his contract with the U. S. Government to transport mail, now

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Roscoe Venard in Decision No. 6018 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
