THE RAILROAD COMMISSION HEREBY DECLARES that pursuant to Decision No. 17881, dated January 12, 1927, Roseville Water Company has filed in the above entitled matter in satisfactory form a stipulation duly authorized by its Board of Directors, in which it agrees, among other things, that it will not declare or pay any dividends on its outstanding stock until it has invested the sum of \$6,002.30 of surplus earnings in fixed capital or in a special cash fund for said purpose and that it will not ask the Commission to authorize the issue of stock, bonds or other evidences of indebtedness against said investment.
