## SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Commission by its Decision No. 18100, on Application No. 12886, dated March 21, 1927, granted to Enrico N. Cuneo a certificate for the operation of an automobile passenger stage line between Cook's Station and Ranger Station, and intermediate points, as an extension of said applicant's present authorized service, and

WHEREAS, it was the intention of the Railroad Commission in its order above referred to to grant an operating right for the transportation of passengers, baggage and freight,

NOW, THEREFORE, good cause appearing, and the Commission being fully advised, it is hereby ordered that the declaration appearing in this Commission's Decision No. 18100 on Application No. 12886, as decided March 21, 1927, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

The Railroad Commission of the State of California hereby declares that public convenience and necessity require the operation by Enrico N. Cuneo of an automobile stage line as a common carrier of passengers, baggage and freight between Cook's Station and Ranger Station, and intermediate points, not as a new and separate certificate but as an extension of his present authorized service.
