ORDER OF DISMISSAL

In this proceeding, Pacific Gas and Electric Company asks the Commission to deny the request of Utica Mining Company for approval of an agreement with Calaveras Copper Company, dated June 19, 1925.

A public hearing was held October 9, 1925, before Commissioner Whitsett. Decision was withheld, pending negotiations between interested parties.

Under date of April 6, 1927, Utica Mining Company withdrew their request for approval of said agreement and, under date of April 8th, Pacific Gas and Electric Company asked dismissal of the proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the above-entitled matter, being Case 2150, be and the same is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
