SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, H. V. Iredell, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 13766, dated July 1, 1924, and issued on Application No. 10207, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing him to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and packages between Santa Ana and Serra and certain intermediate points, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of April 12, 1927, that because of the wrecking of his only car in an accident and his inability, because of financial stress, to obtain new or other equipment, he has been forced to discontinue the above described service, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to said H. V. Iredell in Decision No. 13766 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
