James, who, by the Railroad Commission's Decision No.11582, dated February 3, 1923, and issued on Application No.8613, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of persons and property between Mariposa, Mt. Bullion and Bagby, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of April 16, 1927, that he discontinued operation of the service on July 1, 1926, following loss of contract to carry mail between Mariposa and Bagby, now

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to S. L. James in Decision No.11582 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
