SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, James W. Smith, to whom the Railroad Commission in its Decision No. 11080, dated October 7, 1922, and issued on Application No. 8141, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers between Ankum and Plymouth, serving Oleta as an intermediate point, has advised the Commission, in writing, under date of April 20, 1927, that with the loss, in June, 1926, of his contract to carry U. S. mail he discontinued operation of the stage service he was conducting under authority of the above described operating right, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to James W. Smith in Decision No. 11080 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
