In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for authority to abandon non-agency station at Chimnti, County of Fresno, State of California.

## ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, a coporation, has filed with the Commission an application for an order authorizing the abandonment of its non-agency station of Chimnti on its Stockton Division in Fresno County, State of California.

Applicant alleges that no passenger business was transacted at the non-agency station of Chimnti during the annual period ending December 31, 1926; that it is a Class "E" Station, that there are no facilities at said station and that no freight is ever handled at said station, that the abandonment of said non-agency station will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; and that, in the opinion of applicant, the continued maintenance of the non-agency station is not necessary for the business of the applicant or for the public.

The California Farm Bureau Federation has been consulted in the matter and has advised the Commission that they have no objection to offer to the granting of the application.

It appears to the Commission that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that permission and anthority be and it is hereby granted to Southern Pacific Company, a corporation, to abandon its non-agency station of Chimnti located on the Biola Branch of its Stockton Division in Fresho County, state of California, and to eliminate said non-agency name from its station records.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the date hereof.
