IT IS WEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to Dubourdieu and Hunt by the Rail - road Commission in its Decision No.7226, dated March 8, 1920, and issued on Application No.3996 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled; provided

That Charles Dubourdieu, Jr., for the partnership of Dubourdieu and Hunt, shall immediately file supplements to tariffs and time schedules on file with the Railroad Commission in his name, which supplements shall contain notice of withdrawal of said tariffs and time schedules.
