Taresh, to whom the Commission in its Decision No.10557, dated June 8, 1922, and issued on Application No.7908, granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate an automobile service for the transportation of passengers and property between Veramont and Genessee, serving Taylorsville as an intermediate point, has advised the Railroad Commission, in writing, under date of April 29, 1927, that following the loss of his contract with the U. S. Government to transport mail between the above named points he discontinued said service, now

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the certificate of public convenience and necessity heretofore granted to J. H. Taresh in Decision No.10557 be and the same hereby is revoked and annulled.
