Good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the One Hundred and Twenty-second Supplemental Order of November 15, 1924, in the above entitled proceeding be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the time during which City of Los Angeles may reconstruct its overhead electric lines to conform to the provisions of Chapter 499, Statutes of 1911 as amended by Chapter 600, Statutes of 1915, be and the same is hereby extended to January 1, 1928, provided that as to certain infractions listed as "technical, prior to October 22, 1911" upon copies of field reports heretofore referred to, such time is hereby extended until such infractions can be eliminated in the course of maintenance or construction work."
