SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

WHEREAS, the Railroad Commission in its Decision No.18337, granting to the Union Pacific Stage Company, a corporation, a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to operate an automobile service in Death Valley, required in condition II of its order that the company

*****shall commence operation of the service herein authorized within a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days from date hereof, and

WHERMAS, such time of starting operations is in conflict with the terms of said certificate, which provides for a season-al operation, to wit: between October 1st and May 15th of each year, now

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that condition II hereinabove referred to be and the same hereby is changed to read as follows:

II- Applicant shall file, in duplicate, time schedules and tariff of rates within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from date hereof, such tariff of rates and time schedules to be identical with those attached to the application herein, or rates and time schedules satisfactory to the Railroad Commission, and shall commence operation of said service on October 1, 1927.

In all other respects the order herein is to remain unchanged.
