ORDER

Roy Wilbur, who owns and operates a water system serving consumers in Camarillo and vicinity, having made application to this Commission to transfer said system for a consideration of \$900.00 to H. Dizdar, who joins in the application, and, it appearing that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Roy Wilbur be and he is hereby authorized to transfer to H. Dizdar for a consideration of \$900.00 the water system in Camarillo as more particularly described in the application herein, subject to the following terms and conditions:

- l. The consideration for this property shall not be urged before this Commission or any other public body as a finding of value of such properties for rate fixing or any purpose other than the transfer herein authorized.
- 2. The authority herein granted shall apply only to such transfer as shall have been made on or before the thirty-first (31st) day of July, 1927, and a certified copy of the final instrument of conveyance shall be filed with this commission by Roy Wilbur within thirty (30) days from the date on which it is executed.

3. Within thirty (30) days from the date on which Roy Wilbur actually relinquishes control and possession of the properties herein authorized to be transferred, he shall file with this Commission a certified statement setting forth the date on which such control and possession was relinquished.

The authority herein granted shall become effective upon the date hereof.
